# LUKE 8:40-42

**Now when Jesus returned, the crowd welcomed him, for they were all waiting for him. And there came a man named Jairus, who was a ruler of the synagogue. And falling at Jesus' feet, he implored him to come to his house, for he had an only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she was dying...**



# LUKE 8:40-42

**...As Jesus went, the people pressed  
around him.**



# **LUKE 8:43-48**

**And there was a woman who had had a discharge of blood for twelve years, and though she had spent all her living on physicians, she could not be healed by anyone. She came up behind him and touched the fringe of his garment, and immediately her discharge of blood ceased. And Jesus said, "Who was it that**



# LUKE 8:43-48

**...When all denied it, Peter said, "Master, the crowds surround you and are pressing in on you!" But Jesus said, "Someone touched me, for I perceive that power has gone out from me."...**



# LUKE 8:43-48

**...And when the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came trembling, and falling down before him declared in the presence of all the people why she had touched him, and how she had been immediately healed. And he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace."**



# Mark 5:26

**(she) had suffered much under many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was no better but rather grew worse**



# TALMUD

**“Take of the gum of the Alexandria the weight of a small silver coin; of alum the same; of crocus the same. Let them be bruised together and given in wine to the woman that has an issue of blood. If this does not benefit take of Persian onions three pints; boil them in wine, and give her to drink, and say ‘Arise from thy**





# TALMUD

**...If this does not cure her, set her in a place where two ways meet, and let her hold a cup of wine in her right hand and let someone come behind and frighten her and say, ‘Arise from thy flux,’”**



# Leviticus 15:19

**"When a woman has a discharge, and the discharge in her body is blood, she shall be in her menstrual impurity for seven days, and whoever touches her shall be unclean until the evening..."**



# Leviticus 15:25

**"If a woman has a discharge of blood for many days, not at the time of her menstrual impurity, or if she has a discharge beyond the time of her impurity, all the days of the discharge she shall continue in uncleanness. As in the days of her impurity, she shall be unclean.**



# LUKE 8:49-56

While he was still speaking, someone from the ruler's house came and said, "Your daughter is dead; do not trouble the Teacher any more." But Jesus on hearing this answered him, "Do not fear; only believe, and she will be well." And when he came to the house, he allowed no one to enter with him,...



# LUKE 8:49-56

**...except Peter and John and James, and the father and mother of the child. And all were weeping and mourning for her, but he said, "Do not weep, for she is not dead but sleeping." And they laughed at him, knowing that she was dead. But taking her by the hand he called, saying, "Child, arise."...**



# LUKE 8:49-56

**...And her spirit returned, and she got up at once. And he directed that something should be given her to eat. And her parents were amazed, but he charged them to tell no one what had happened.**
