

Luke 9:18-22

¹⁸ Now it happened that as he was praying alone, the disciples were with him. And he asked them, "Who do the crowds say that I am?" ¹⁹ And they answered, "John the Baptist. But others say, Elijah, and others, that one of the prophets of old has risen."

LUKE 9:18-22 ²⁰ Then he said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" And Peter answered, "The Christ of God."

Jesus is the Christ who suffered and rose from the dead according to God's plan.



1. Jesus isn't just a person; He is God incarnate. (vv.18-20)

Luke 2:11

For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.

Luke 2:26

And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

Like 4:41 demons came out of many, crying, "You

are the Son of God!" ... because they knew that he was the Christ.



2. Jesus doesn't just proclaim the good news; He is the good news. (vv.21-22)

Luke 9.2 ²¹ And he strictly charged and commanded them to tell this to no one, ²² saying, "The Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised."



3. Jesus didn't just predict these glorious events; He planned them. (vv.21-22)

Ephesians 1:4-5

⁴ ...he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love
⁵ he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will
