The Lord's Prayer is Christ's model prayer that reorients us on the gospel story.



1. The Lord's Prayer is both a model AND prescriptive.



2. The Lord's Prayer shows that our prayers will normally be brief and often.

7"And when you pray, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do, for they think that they will be heard for their many words. 8Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

*MATTHEW 6:7-8 (ESV)* 



3. The Lord's Prayer is a **proactive** act of dependance.

<sup>14</sup>For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you, <sup>15</sup>but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

## Three Petitions

3. Deliverance – "Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil."

<sup>13</sup>Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God," for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one.

*JAMES 1:13 (ESV)* 

<sup>39</sup>"...My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will."

*MATTHEW 26:39 (ESV)* 

<sup>41</sup>"Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak."

*MATTHEW 26:41 (ESV)* 

42"My Father, if this cannot pass unless I drink it, your will be done."

*MATTHEW 26:42 (ESV)*
